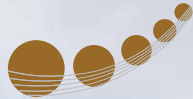

The Finnish composer, Sibelius, is as consciously nationalistic as Grieg. Join us to bask in their distinctive musical language which mirrors the landscape of their countries.

Sibelius' Concerto for Violin, performed by New Zealander Simeon Broom – who returns from the UK to perform with the Manukau Symphony Orchestra – sparkles with glitter, personality and style.

From the opening 'Morning' to the closing 'In the Hall of the Mountain King', Grieg's 'Peer Gynt' Suite leads us on an epic journey through Norway.

And Belgian conductor, Ivan Meylemans, who worked with Manukau Symphony Orchestra in 2008, brings us dances from his own country by Daniel Sternefeld.
